### Directions

From the Twin Cities: Take 35E or 35W to Highway 97 (it is the first exit after 35E and 35W join together). Travel east on Highway 97 a mile and a half to Highway 61 North for one quarter mile to Highway 97. Travel east on Highway 97 for another mile a half to Harrow Avenue. Take Harrow Avenue South (right) for a half-mile and you will see the golf course and entrance.

### Tournament and Course Information

- The lounge will be open at 10:00 a.m. for refreshments.
- A practice range and putting green are available.
- Locker rooms are available for both men and women.

### Important notes

Metal spikes are not allowed at Forest Hills—soft spikes or tennis shoes are acceptable. Please remove your metal spikes prior to the tournament.
